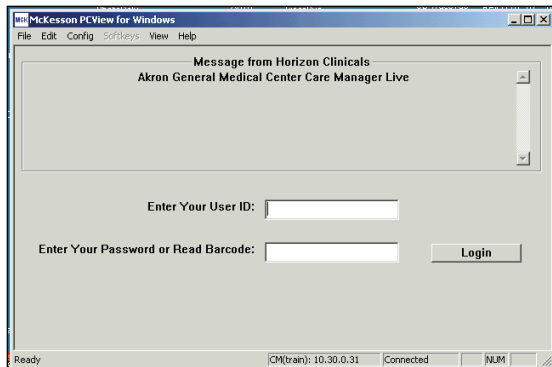


Components of Documentation System

- McKesson Horizon Care Manager application includes the following modules:
- Care Organizer – manage orders and patient care (currently limited to med orders).
- Admin-Rx – medication administration documentation.
- Horizon Expert Documentation (HED) – clinical documentation system with interfaces to ADT, Lab, Radiology, Respiratory.

Logging Into the System



- Swipe ID badge over One-Sign device NS-XX badge number will appear.
- Type in password - AGMC123
- The PC desktop should become available.
- Log-in to McKesson application by double clicking on the McKesson Care Manager icon.
- Auto login will occur without a password.

Assigning Your Patient to You

- It is important that you assign your patient to you.
- This assists you to go directly to your patient when logging in.
- This also documents the times that you are caring for the patient as opposed to when your RN is providing care.
- Be sure that you specify the exact times you are working with the patient. For example if you do not work an entire shift do not record 7A-7P or it looks like you cared for the patient when you did not.
- Select Utilities

- Select the following information:
- Provider Type: STDN
- Care Relations: Student Nurse
- When you select Student Nurse, Day Shift will automatically appear. You need to adjust your start and stop time to your actual times.

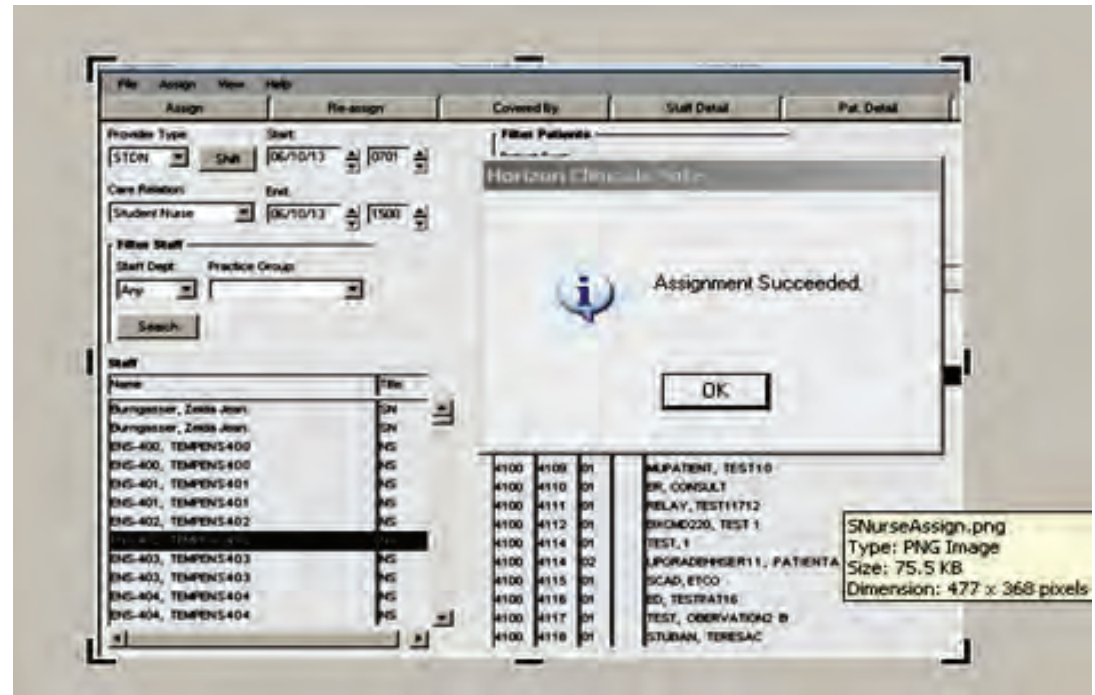

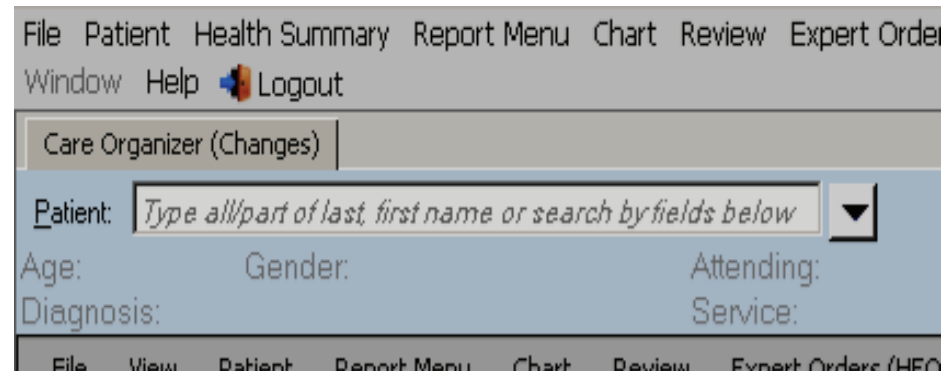



- Right click the annotation to open it completely.

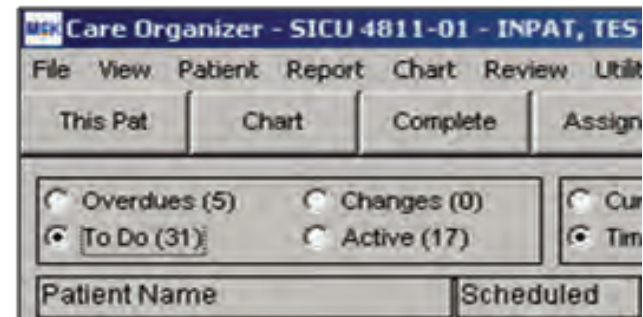

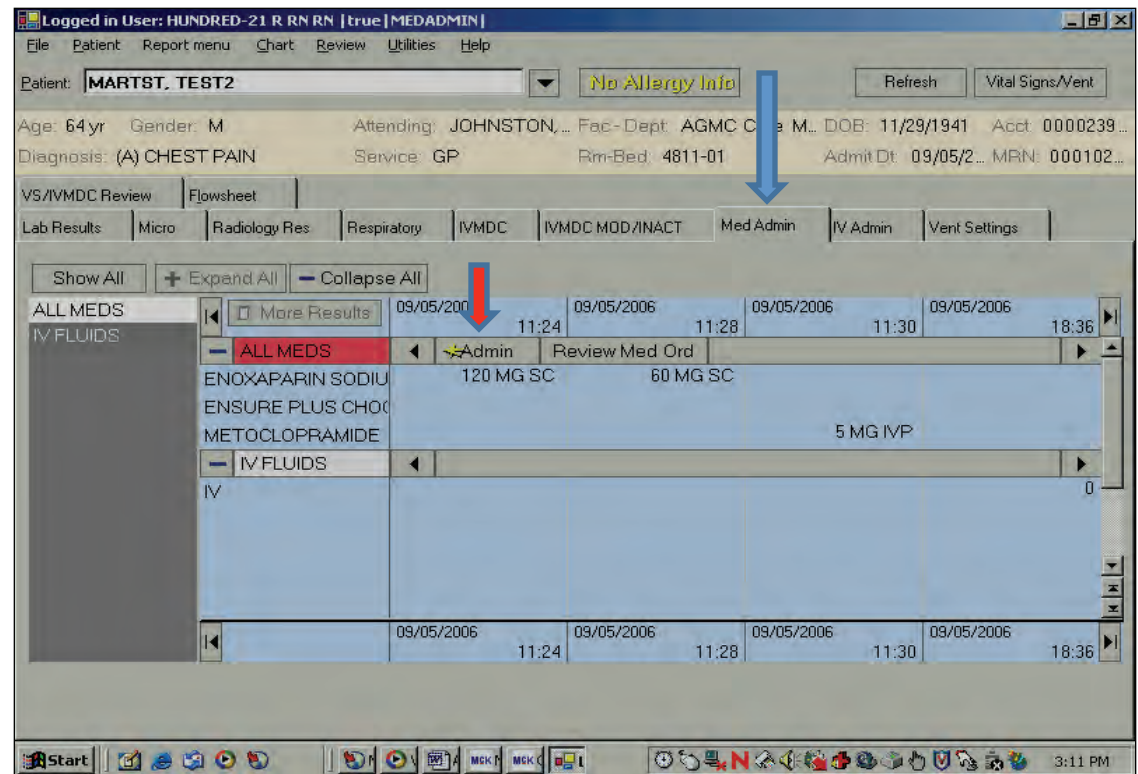
Preparing for Medication Administration

- Care Organizer defaults to the Changes screen so that new orders entered on the patient can be viewed immediately after signing into McKesson Clinicals.
- Depending on what you are needing to perform. You may need to select “To Do” or “Active” to review medications.



Getting Ready to Give Medications

- When you are ready to give medications you need to click on HED
- Then click on Med Admin.
- Then click on Admin.

Scanning the Medication



- Point the scanner at the medication barcode.
- Squeeze the handle and the medication dosage will appear on the screen.
- Do this scanning so that you can watch your screen and your medication bar code together.

Reviewing Your Dosages

- After scanning the medication barcode, the medication dose and quantity appears in the box to the right of the medication to identify the right drug, right dose, right time, right route.

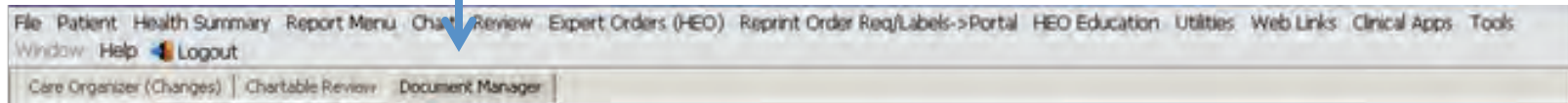
