Adolescents

- Physically and verbally striking out
- Excessive crying and tearfulness
- Negativity
- Problems with concentration
- Inability or refusal to take direction
- Isolation or lack of communication with family and peers
- Dramatic changes in grades at school
- Behavioral or attendance referrals from schools
- Secretiveness about friends or running with "wrong" peers
- Self-harming activities
- Bullying
- Unusual irritability
- Changes in personal hygiene or appearance

Adults

- Feelings of depression
- Inability to handle stresses at home or work
- Abuse of alcohol or other drugs
- Changes in sleeping and eating habits
- Interpersonal relationship problems
- Loss of interest in sex
- Unexplained fearfulness
- Mood swings
- Angry much of the time
- Memory lapse

Older Adults

- Inability to concentrate
- Decreased energy
- Changes in sleeping and eating habits
- Memory loss
- Difficulty handling stress
- Grieving for unusually long periods of time
- Withdrawal from family and friends
- Refusal to leave home or participate in activities
- Ongoing irritability
- Dependence on alcohol or other drugs
- Lack of interest in activities
- Changes in personal hygiene and appearance
